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ACLS Cardiac Arrest Algorithm for Suspected

Shock Energy for Defibrillation Biphasic: Manufacturer recommendation (eg, initial dose of 120-200 J); if unknown, use maximum available. Second and subsequent doses should be equivalent, and higher doses may be considered.

ACLS Megacode Testing Scenarios

Megacode 1— Out-of-Hospital Unstable Bradycardia (Unstable Bradycardia > pVT > PEA > PCAC)

Lead-in: You are a paramedic treating a man who had a syncopal episode.
