- Last Oral Intake: When did the patient last eat or drink?
- Events Leading to the Illness/Injury: What happened?

Understanding the ABCDEs: After scene safety and a quick SAMPLE assessment, prioritize the ABCDEs of primary assessment:

Airway: Is the airway open and clear? Address any obstructions.

Breathing: Is the patient breathing adequately? Rate, rhythm, depth.

Circulation: Check for pulse, skin color, and capillary refill time. Control any major bleeding.

Disability: Assess neurological status - level of consciousness (AVPU).

Exposure: Expose the patient to perform a full body assessment, while maintaining their warmth and dignity.

Essential Medications and Their Uses (EMT Cheat Sheet)

Oxygen (O₂): Administered to improve tissue oxygenation in cases of hypoxia.

Aspirin: Used to help prevent blood clot formation in suspected myocardial infarction (heart attack).

Nitroglycerin: Dilates blood vessels to reduce chest pain in angina and myocardial infarction.

Albuterol: Bronchodilator for asthma and other respiratory distress.

Epinephrine: Used in anaphylaxis to counteract the effects of an allergic reaction.

Key Considerations for Medication Administration:

Dosage: Always confirm the correct dosage before administration.

Route: Understand the proper route of administration (oral, inhalation, intravenous, intramuscular).

Contraindications: Be aware of any contraindications or potential adverse effects.

Trauma Management: A Quick Overview

Trauma management requires a systematic approach. Remember the primary assessment (ABCDEs) and then move to secondary assessment, including a thorough head-to-toe examination. Recognizing Shock:

Shock is a life-threatening condition. Signs include:

Altered mental status

Cardiac Arrest and CPR

Cardiac arrest requires immediate intervention. Initiate CPR, including chest compressions and rescue breaths, according to current guidelines. Use an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) as soon as possible. Early defibrillation dramatically improves chances of survival.

CPR Essentials:

Chest Compressions: Deep and consistent compressions at the correct rate.

Rescue Breaths: Adequate breaths to maintain ventilation.

AED Use: Follow the AED prompts carefully.

Medical Emergencies: A Glimpse into Common Scenarios
