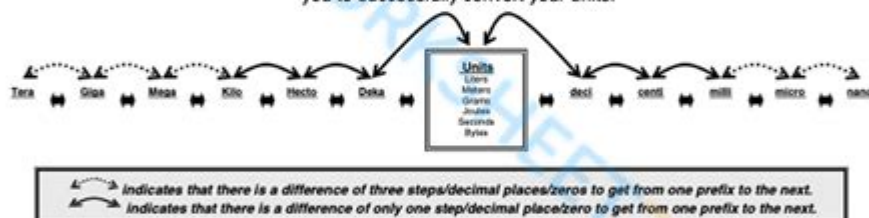

These are the metric units. The letter in the first column is used as the *prefix* before the unit. Some common types of units are: **grams (g)**, **meters (m)**, **liters (L)**, **joules (J)**, **seconds (s)**, and **bytes (B)**.

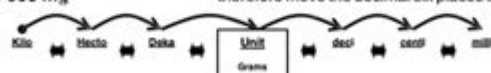
When working in the metric system it is helpful to use a "metric map." This metric map will enable you to successfully convert your units.



### EXAMPLES

1.0 kg = 2 mg

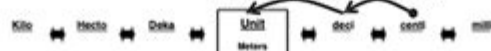
1.0 kg = 1 000 000 mg



kilo and milli differ by six steps/decimal places/zeros;  
kilo  $\square$  milli is going to the right on the "map";  
therefore move the decimal six places to the right

2.3 cm = 2 m

2.3 cm = 0.023 m



centi and no prefix (unit) differ by two  
steps/decimal places/zeros; centi  $\square$  no  
(unit) is going to the left on the "map"; therefore move  
the decimal two places to the left
